Students completing the three courses in a career program area (career pathway) have the following opportunities:

End-of-Pathway Assessment
(certification from industry recognized agency)

Work Based Learning/Internship (career-related work experience)

*Second and third level courses in Computer Science and Programming qualify for the following:

- Science elective credit
- Extra .5 weight calculated for each course on GPA
- HOPE Scholarship Eligible courses

Students taking the 2nd level course in Sports Medicine have the opportunity to earn dual credit in CTAE and Science (Anatomy/Physiology)

Students in the Teaching as a Profession pathway have the opportunity to earn one University System of Georgia college credit if all program requirements are met

Students who take 3 courses in NJROTC are eligible to earn the Health/Personal Fitness PE credit

Students have the opportunity to earn up to 3 Career Ready Diploma Seals at Graduation if all requirements are met in Employability, Pathway and Leadership

Students who complete a pathway (three courses) and pass the End-of-Pathway assessment will be eligible to wear a CTAE Certified Graduation cord (student purchased)
