II. Pathway Name

- 1. Architecture Drawing and Design (AD D)
- 2. Engineering Drawing and Design (ED&D)

These two Career Cluster Pathways offered at North Cobb are also referred to as Drafting.

III. Pathway Description

You will understand and demonstrate how drafting connects to everything. Training provided in the Architectural Drawing and Design takes you through a process for building design, reading building drawings, and presenting those idea. For Engineering Drawing and Design, the process of designing manufactured parts, reading working drawings, and presenting those ideas is understood. Demonstration of drafting knowledge and skills attained will reflect the goal of presenting the idea effectively to an audience. The Introduction to Engineering Drawing and Design is the foundational class for both pathways. Successful completion of three sequential classes of a pathway is known as a pathway completer. A pathway completer will take an End of Pathway Assessment (Revit or Inventor User Certification) and be eligible to wear a CTAE graduation cord and have a pathway completer seal upon your diploma.
